London Dry in Langa Style

From a land boasting such a wealth of excellence as Piedmont and the UNESCO world heritage hills of the Langa comes the continuation of a tradition of generations of craft spirits, bitters and vermouths.

In our artisanal production we only use natural infusions and distillates made in-house.

The small batch spirits are produced using two 18th-century wood-fired copper stills. And the traditional "one-shot" gin production process followed uses the botanicals only once.

The wild mountain plants we use come from the hills of the Langa and the Maritime Alps surrounding our region, and are all picked by hand by local inhabitants who supply them to the distillery each season.

Elena Gin has notes of mountain juniper and slightly citrusy aromatic herbs. The floral aromas are reminiscent of the meadows in the Langa and the Alps in summer. A very long oily sensation fills the mouth, enveloping the palate.
