Points **2016 La Valentina *Pecorino***
Colline Pescaresse IGT

Vivid straw-yellow. Lemon and spices on the nose, but also a strong note of banana. Bright, fresh and easygoing on the palate, offering pear, banana and ripe peach flavors. Finishes long with a slight phenolic edge but also good sweetness of fruit. Well-made in a tough year, but not the most characteristic example of Pecorino wine you'll ever drink, and thus I have lowered my score accordingly.
