



Scarrone Vigna Vecchia

The vineyard is located in the Scarrone area of Castiglione Falletto; slightly larger than one hectare, facing south-east. The vines are over 90 years of age, with a density of 4,300 plants/he.

The naturally low yields, due to the age, are further reduced by a strict selection of the grapes, about 25 hl/ha. Then there is a short period of cold macerations followed by 2 weeks of alcoholic fermentation in steel vats. The wine macerates on skins for another week or so.

Bottled unfiltered.

Points Barbera d'Alba DOC

The 2015 Barbera d'Alba Vigna Vecchia Scarrone is a beautifully crafted and accessible wine made with fruit from a historic vineyard. Luca Currado opted not to make Barbera in the difficult 2014 vintage. This wine opens to immediate density and richness. It shows succulent aromas of blackberry, spice, tar and dark plum that build the wine's soaring aromatic profile. Earthy tones of forest floor and black truffle also appear. The mouthfeel is on the soft side (of the Barbera spectrum) and there is a playful point of sweetness as well.
