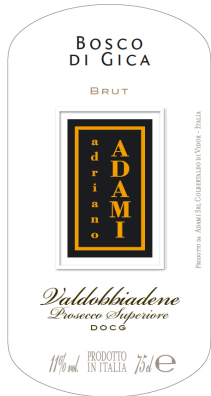


VINOUS - TIS THE SEASON FOR SPARKLING WINE

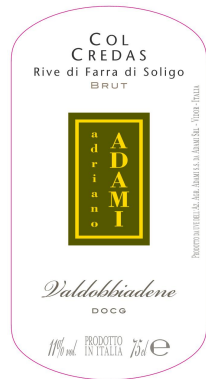

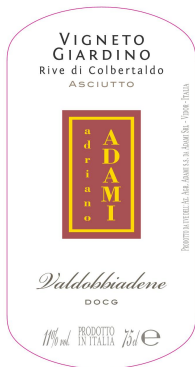
Adami Bosco di Gica Brut Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Prosecco Superiore

NV - The NV Brut Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Bosco di Gica entices with a bouquet that's more savory than sweet. A note of green apple mixes with mint leaf and wet stone hints. It impresses further with its mix of tension and elegance. Brisk acidity and tart orchard fruits contrast its creamy wave of fine bubbles. A saline tinge lingers on along with a Granny Smith resonance that keeps the senses salivating as this finishes with excellent length and freshness. This is a fantastic value. **92**



Adami "Col Credas" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Rive di Farra di Soligo Extra

Brut 2023 - The 2023 Extra Brut Valdobbiadene Col Credas Rive di Farra di Soligo bursts from the glass with a complex blend of dried flowers, stone dust, ground ginger and crushed green apple. This is chiseled in feel, with a crunch of saline minerals and zesty acidity that balance its elegant and soothingly round persona. The 2023 tapers off with tension, with a lingering pleasantly bitter tinge that leaves the mouth watering. **93**



Adami "Vigneto Giardino" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Rive di Colbertaldo

Asciutto 2023 - The 2023 Valdobbiadene Vigneto Giardino Rive di Colbertaldo Asciutto is delicate yet remarkably pretty, wafting up with a cascade of floral perfumes and hints of sweet spice, peach sorbet and nectarine. It floods the palate with a creamy bead of fine bubbles and ripe orchard fruits, all guided by brilliant acidity as a nuance of candied citrus informs the close. Notes of green apple, melon and a sensation of liquid stone appear as the 2023 finishes with amazing length and complexity. This is fantastic. **93+**
