



2017 Badia a Coltibuono Chianti Classico

Vibrant aromas of cherries, tangy currants, cranberry sauce, with elements of menthol, roses, spiced tea. Crisp acidity frames the wine nicely, the tannins have structure but round edges, on a medium-bodied frame. Fresh, tangy, red and black currants, topped with tobacco, oregano, soy, earth, with violets and coffee tones. Could use a year or two, but it is accessible now, and opens up nicely, showing some complexity and balance for the price.
