Medium ruby color. Bright and expressive on the nose with chilled strawberries and red currants, topped with roses, violets, pepper, and oregano notes. The palate shows fresh acidity, moderate tannins but not harsh edges or greenness here. Fresh red cherries and currants, tossed well with earthy, rocky, charcoal notes, along with a pleasant mix of herbs and flowers. This shows a lot of class for a Barolo at this price. It drinks well now, but I'd like to check back in two or three years.
