Light purple color. A rich, deep, fruit-forward nose of black cherries, red and black currants, with a mix of earth, tar, pepper and violets. Moderate acidity on the palate, some smooth tannins, and lots of plush, ripe black cherry and roasted fig fruit. The concentration and jamminess of the fruit is significant, but there's also some violets, coffee and grilled herbs to add some other elements. A chewy, riper style of Nebbiolo for early drinking.
