Cherry, tar and licorice aromas and flavors are the hallmarks of this ripe yet well-structured red. Hints of leather and tobacco round this out. Winds down, with dusty tannins on the lingering finish. Best from 2020-2032.

A dense style, with fresh rose, cherry, licorice, tar and tobacco flavors aligned to a vibrant, refined frame. This is structured, feeling closed right now but remaining well-proportioned, with a firm, long finish.
