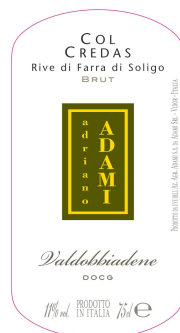


Adami "Vigneto Giardino" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Rive di Colbertaldo Asciutto

2020 - The 2020 Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Rive di Colbertaldo Vigneto Giardino Dry is another classic wine from the charismatic Franco Adami. This festive bottle shows aromas of honeysuckle, candied lemon, crushed stone and Golden Delicious apple. Franco writes "Asciutto" in Italian instead of the English "Dry," and there's a lot to read into that. Is this a protest against the fact that the word Dry is confusing to the consumer? Production is 40,200 bottles. **91**



Adami "Col Creadas" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Rive di Farra di Soligo Extra Brut

2020 - The 2020 Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Rive di Farra di Soligo Col Creadas Extra Brut shows very slight golden saturation to its appearance. It offers a richer fruit profile with apricot, lemon zest and bitter almond with the tonic dryness that Extra Brut brings. This wine has been in production since the 2011 vintage, and fruit comes from a site that is ideal for pas dosé wines. Production is 13,000 bottles. **90**



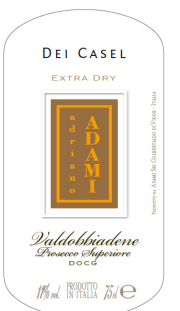
Adami "Col Fondo" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Prosecco Superiore Sul Lieviti Brut Nature

2020 - Here's a fun way to interpret the versatile Glera grape. The Adami 2020 Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Sui Lieviti Col Fondo Brut Nature has a very distinctive bouquet with mature fruit, apricot, crushed stone and panettone-style baked brioche. The wine is tight and streamlined to the palate, with firm beading, but the bouquet really is special. You could push this wine for an extra year or two of bottle age, and you might see some yeasts deposits at the bottom. This is a 9,200-bottle production. **91**



Adami Bosco di Gica Brut Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Prosecco Superiore NV - A

classic wine from one of the region's top producers, the Adami NV Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Bosco di Gica Brut is steely and tonic with pummelo, white grapefruit and unripe pear. There are crisp mineral tones of crushed rock and sandstone. This is your quintessential Brut-styled Prosecco Superiore. The wine represents a blend of fruit from 34 different lots, and an ample 330,000 bottles were made. **89**



Adami "Dei Casel" Valdobbiadene D.O.C.G. Prosecco Superiore Extra Dry NV -

The Adami NV Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore Dei Casel Extra Dry offers a hint of sweetness with summer nectarine, jasmine and wild sage. This is a smooth and very pretty Italian sparkler with soft beading and fresh acidity to close. The wine represents fruit from 34 parcels that are fermented separately before the final blend is made in January or February following the harvest. Production is 95,000 bottles. **90**
