Barbera is a grape variety that can be a profound wine. However, to achieve this, Barbera must to be awarded a superb site. Scarrone is such a site. Located in the heart of the Barolo zone, Scarrone is tiny: just 2.8 hectares

or 6.9 acres. Yet even in a such a small site, we have made a distinction: Scarrone "VIGNA VECCHIA" or "Old Vines". The "Vigna Vecchia" subplot of Scarrone is just 2.5 acres of Barbera vines that are nearly one-half century old, Typically, just 280 cases a year are produced. Few, if any, Barbera wines are longer lived than Scarrone. This is because of a rare subsoil known as "blue tufo", a type of chalky clay. The influence of this soil is demonstrated by the great Rocche vineyard, which makes one of the longest-lived Barolos. Both Rocche and Scarrone are on the same alignment of blue tufo within 500 feet of each other. Even though "Scarrone" is Barbera and "Rocche" is Nebbiolo, both share a similar quisto della terra - a taste of the soil.

Scarrone will reward five, ten or even more years of cellaring. It always a firm, rich wine with enormous detail. Truly, it is not a Barbera - it is Scarrone. This "Vigna Vecchia" bottling is Scarrone magnified, thanks to the age of the vines and their extremely low yield.
