Superiore Rive di Colbertaldo Asciutto
Vigneto Giardino**

Vivid straw-green with a steady stream of small bubbles.
Drop-dead gorgeous Prosecco with white peach, nectarine, honey,
anise, chamomile, vanilla and flint only some of the many aromas
and flavors that open up with aeration, lending this deep, luscious
(20 g/L residual sugar and 6 g/L total acidity), almost chewy
Prosecco an irresistible exotic, complex touch. Best Asciutto
Prosecco of the year (it was previously labeled as 'Dry', but
Adami has reversed to the old moniker of Asciutto). In fact, in
1933, this wine was presented at the First Traditional Wines
Exhibition of Siena as 'Riva Giardino Asciutto'; historically, it was
one of the first, if not the first, single vineyard Prosecco made.
