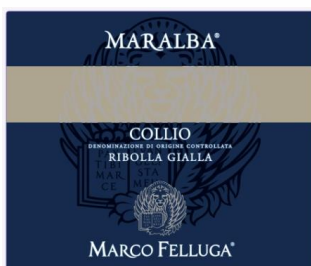


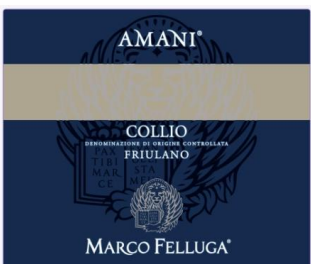

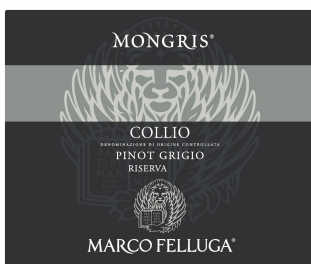
MARCO FELLUGA MonGris Pinot Grigio Collio DOC 2019 ~ The 2019 Pinot Grigio Mongris is a spicy, savory expression of the grape, fresh and more floral than fruity. It's silky textures usher in citrus-tinged orchard fruits and salty minerals, creating an energetic and tactile display. Hints of lime and residual acids sizzle through the finale, making it hard to resist another sip. **91 points**



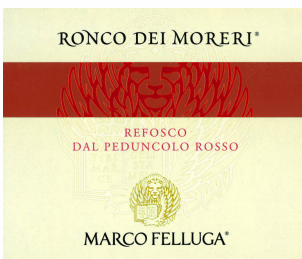
MARCO FELLUGA Maralba Pinot Ribolla Gialla Collio DOC 2019 ~ The 2019 Ribolla Gialla Maralba stands out for its rich and earthy personality. Layers of ripe apricot, apple and sweet spice give way to notes of candied ginger and floral undergrowth. The textures are silky, coasting across a medium-bodied frame with building tension, as ripe orchard fruits give way to zesty green citrus. It's structured yet clean and balanced, with lasting minerality. **91 points**



MARCO FELLUGA Amani Friulano Collio DOC 2019 - The 2019 Friulano Amani lifts up with an exotic display of tropical citrus and hints of spice, then slowly settles and evolves to show ripe apple with pretty white flowers. It's wonderfully poised and balanced, showing an attractive inner sweetness to its orchard fruits, contrasted by salty minerals adding a tactile feel. Hints of vanilla bean, peaches and mint linger, provided a fully satisfying finale. **91 points**



MARCO FELLUGA MonGris Pinot Grigio Riserva DOC 2017 - The 2017 Pinot Grigio Mongris Riserva is sweetly perfumed and exotic, as dried peaches and nectarine give way to notes of lemon confit, white smoke and vanilla bean. It has suave, silky textures that coast across a medium-bodied frame, all held in perfect balance by vibrant acids. Ripe apples, pears, melon and even a spearmint freshness make an appearance, marked by stimulating minerality, all under an air of sweet florals. This extroverted and structured Pinot Grigio is sure to win a lot of fans and excel over the medium term in our cellars. The Mongris gains its character and richness through partial fermentation in five hectoliter oak barrels, followed by two years refining on the lees prior to bottling. **92 points**



MARCO FELLUGA Ronco dei Moreri Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso IGT 2015 - The 2015 Refosco dal Peduncolo Rosso Ronco dei Moreri has a lot of upfront appeal, displaying a mix of wildberries, mint, sage and autumnal spices. Its textures are silky, giving way to polished black fruits, complicated by a complex web of minerals and fine-grained tannins. The 2015 could use another year or two to come into focus, and there's enough structural heft and primary components here to carry this for many years in the cellar. **90 points**
