The nose is rather shy but eventually reveals whiffs of dark-skinned fruit, underbrush, coconut, and a hint of camphor. It's medium bodied but firm, offering mature black cherry, licorice and a hint of espresso set against grainy tannins that grip the somewhat dusty, drying finish. — *Kerin O'Keefe*



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
