Sangioveto (originally San Zoveto) was the common name for the Sangiovese varietal in the past. 100% Sangiovese from Monti in Chianti, a frazione of Gaiole in Chianti; unlike other wines from this producer, this wine was aged in French barriques. Morel cherry, cumin and tobacco aromas. Medium-full, with more noticeable oak aromas, there are medium-full tannins, good acidity and very good persistence. Give this 2-3 years to round out; peak in 7-10 years.
