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Covering the southwestern slope of Martinenga, below Rabajà, Camp Gros always released a year after Gaiun shares some of Rabajà's robustness and structure. Despite coming from the easy-going 2018 vintage, it has a nose that leans towards balsamic and angular. Pungent, redcurrant fruit sits alongside soft strawberry, with sharper notes of catnip, eucalyptus and wintergreen, though it is all still in that lilting, delicate register common to di Grézy. The entry hits a bitter note before the acidity brightens it up, ushering in more red fruit. Tannins are imposing and border on hard, forming a rigid central column that only dissipates slowly. The fruit remains crystalline and pure, but the extremes in the structure will likely take some time to converge.
