Slightly richer and fruitier, the [La Valentina](#) Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo is on the light side for a Cerasuolo, but still delivers the bright cherry fruit you might expect from this rendition of the Montepulciano grape. This bottling is organically grown and certified, and a sure bet for your summer afternoons. Pale ruby in the glass, this wine smells of cherries, strawberries, and dried herbs. In the mouth, strawberries, dried herbs, and a hint of cherry have a nice crisp brightness as excellent acidity makes the mouth water. Hints of orange peel in the finish with a faint chalky minerality. Very pretty.
