## Binomio Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC Riserva - 2013

WINE ADVOCATE

Of the various samples in this mini vertical, the Binomio 2013 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva is the most direct, sharp and clearly defined. You get a very good sense of the native Montepulciano grape, thanks to the tight and chiseled aromas of sour cherry, blackberry and wet soil. An elaborate oak regime with three different kinds of French barrique (Allier, Tronçais and Nevers) adds to the wine's dimension, fullness and structural backbone. That slightly rustic and genuine quality that you get in the best Montepulciano d'Abruzzo wines emerges very clearly here. Try it with a platter of mortadella, cicolana sausage, aged pecorino and spicy green olives. Some 13,000 bottles were produced.
