Binomio Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC Riserva - 2012

WINE ADVOCATE

From a scorching hot and dry vintage, the Binomio 2012 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva delivers abundant black fruit with highlights that include dried cherry and blackberry pie. There is a note of sweetness that enhances the soft and chewy quality of fruit obtained in this vintage. Vines for this wine were planted in 1971. Their developed root systems can tap into underground moisture, making them better equipped to handle hot vintages. Pretty notes of spice and smoke push from the back, giving this wine lots of dark intensity and momentum and making it a great choice for a pork sausage and escarole sauté. Some 13,000 bottles were produced.
