The Enrico Serafino 2013 Alta Langa Metodo Classico Riserva Pas Dosé Zero is a delicate and fine expression that shows detailed aromas of grapefruit, cut grass, melon, crushed stone, and talc powder. The wine's beading is tight and sharp. This sparkling wine is made with the Nebbiolo grape, specifically, the Picotener subvariety that this estate has so dutifully brought back to life. The wine represents a blend of fruit from three sites located at high altitudes (at an average of 500 meters above sea level) where the nighttime temperatures are cool and frisky. It ages on the lees for 72 long months, adding to the creamy, mid-weight texture. Some 15,000 bottles were made.
