

OVERVIEW

Lombardy has quite a few IGTs (protected geographic indications), areas for quality wines made outside the restrictions of any of the denominations. The most important of these is Provincia di Pavia IGT, which as the name says is for wines from the province of Pavia. This province in southwestern Lombardy includes the Oltrepò Pavese region as well as territory north of the Po River. This is one of the most fertile agricultural zones of Lombardy, and Provincia di Pavia IGT is among the top 10 IGTs in wine production. Provincia di Pavia IGT allows numerous grape varieties that can be used for red, rosato, and white wines. Its mainstays are red wines made from Croatina, Pinot Nero, or Barbera and white wines made from Riesling, Pinot Grigio, or Moscato Bianco.
