

OVERVIEW

The wine-producing area called Vigneti delle Dolomiti, or Weinberg Dolomiten in German, is an IGT (protected geographic indication), a less restrictive category of wine regions that allows more innovation than a denomination. The names mean Vineyards of the Dolomites, referring to the Dolomite range of the Alps. The Dolomites are an impressive string of mountains, reaching almost 11,000 feet in elevation, that cover both provinces of Trentino Alto Adige as well as the province of Belluno in northwestern Veneto. These three provinces are all included in Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT. Like almost all IGTs, Vigneti delle Dolomiti allows wineries a lot of latitude in the styles of wines they make and the grape varieties they use.
