WINE STORY

Pinot Bianco is a grape that has been cultivated in Alto Adige since the mid-19th century and is one of the main wine varieties cultivated in the region today. Grapes for "Versalto" are sourced from four distinctive vineyard sites and were selected based on differences in soil type, altitude, climate and trellis systems. The Aspmair and Leisterhof vineyards are both near Merano in Northern Alto Adige, while the Palma vineyard is in Penone on the western side of the valley, and Uccelli is in Pochi, on the eastern side of the valley. Spontaneous fermentation took place in large casks and the wine was then aged in oak casks for six months prior to bottling.
