WINE STORY

Alto Adige is one of the few winegrowing areas of Italy with optimum conditions for Pinot Noir (*Pinot Nero* in Italian), which is why it is one of the main red wines produced in the region today. Pinot Noir prefers cool, well-ventilated sites and calcareous gravel soils with a high loam content. The Lageder Pinot Noir comes from selected sites in Appiano, Cortaccia, and Pochi and offers a combination of finesse and body.
