WINE STORY

Enrico Serafino has been producing Nebbiolo wines for 140 years, from vineyards in Barolo as well as on the north side of the Tanaro River. Enrico Serafino Nebbiolo d'Alba is sourced from north of the Tanaro in the communes of Canale and Priocca both of which are also inside Roero DOCG and also from the commune of Alba itself. The softer and sandier soil of the Roero area is perfect for more fruity expressions of Nebbiolo, while the Alba vineyards in the Langhe produce fuller-bodied reds. Enrico Serafino Nebbiolo d'Alba provides elegance and harmony.
