### WINE STORY

The La Crena vineyard, in the commune of Agliano Terme south of Asti, is near the heart of the respected Barbera d'Asti denomination. Here in the Monferrato hills, Vietti sources the grapes for its single-vineyard Barbera d'Asti DOCG from old vines planted in 1932, which were purchased by the winery in 1996, from the Trincherio family. Originally six hectares, now ten hectares with the purchase of an adjacent property.
