Vietti's Barolo DOCG, formerly known as "Castiglione Barolo," is the primary Barolo produced by the winery. Originally named after Castiglione Falletto, the commune where the Vietti winery is situated. With the 2021 vintage, the name "Castiglione" was removed from the front label. The wine contains grapes from a careful selection of the best MGA vineyards in the Barolo zone (Bricco Fiasco, Bussia, Fossati, and Ravera, to name a few), Truly a remarkable expression of Barolo year after year, it's also a remarkable value.
