


WINE STORY

Freisa is an under-the-radar grape type from the Monferrato and Langhe areas of the Piedmont. Dating back to the 16th century, Freisa is a versatile grape that produces a range of wines, from dry still wine to sparkling wine as well as some sweet versions. Vietti's initial release of this wine, called "Vivace" was slightly frizzante. With the 2022 vintage, the wine is made in a still style. Fermentation with 60% whole berries in stainless steel. Malolactic fermentation and aging are carried out in older large oak casks for a year.
