Dolcetto is the lightest of the three primary red grape varieties of Piedmont and an "every day wine" for the Piemontese. The Vietti Trevìe Dolcetto d'Alba is sourced from vineyards in Monforte d'Alba, Novello and Castiglione Falletto - all of which are in the area around Barolo and the city of Alba. Given the provenance of the grapes for this Dolcetto, it tends to be more intense and focused then many others.
